02 Christmas Office Closure Arrangements:

Our office will close for the festive period at 5.00pm on Monday 23rd December 2024 and will re-open as normal at 9.00 am on Friday 3rd January 2025.

If during this time you have an emergency repair please contact our out of hours repairs service on **01595 692387**.

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An emergency arises where there is danger to life or limb or serious damage to property. We aim to undertake emergency repairs within 6 hours and the following are emergencies:

- ✓ A failure in the mains electrical supply, other than a power cut
- ✓ A dangerous electrical fault
- ✓ A burst water pipe or water tank
- ✓ A blocked drain, if there is serious leakage
- ✓ A blocked or totally unusable WC
- A property that is insecure, with a broken window or a damaged door, following an event such as a break-in or possibly storm damage
- ✓ A tenant is locked in or locked out if the person is elderly, disabled, has other special needs or has children in the household

The Association will also complete the following repairs, although these will not be prioritised to be completed within 6 hours of being reported.

- A non-vulnerable tenant who is locked out of their home
- ✓ A containable leak from the heating or hot water system
- ✓ No heating or hot water

Please remember that it is important to ensure that you cover your rent during this time. For those of you who pay by direct debit we will take the monthly payment on the 3 January so it is important that you ensure there are funds in your account.

There are a lot of demands on our money at this time but please ensure that you leave enough to pay your rent.

The Association recognises it has been another difficult year for our tenants due to the ongoing cost-of-living crisis. We appreciate many tenants are struggling with rising food, energy and other costs and our staff have been at the forefront in providing support to our Hjaltland tenants.

We want our tenants to know that Association staff can offer help and support if you are struggling to pay your rent during the festive period.

We can help in the following ways:

- ✓ Assist with benefit claims, such as Universal Credit, Housing Benefit, Community Care Grants
- We can assist you to apply for an additional rent benefit payment if you meet the criteria
- ✓ Signposting you to professional debt advice
- ✓ We can take your rent payments over the phone
- You can set up direct debit and standing order payments to pay your rent

Don't sit at home worrying about your rent or any other money problems. We want to help – if you are struggling financially, speak to us and we can help you. Your rent is a priority; ignoring the problem will only increase your debt and can put your tenancy at risk.

06 Stay safe Stay safe Stay safe

The holiday season is here, and it's time to deck the halls, put up the tree, and enjoy all the festive fun. But amidst all the merriment, danger can lurk. Follow these tips to ensure

your Christmas is filled with joy and not unexpected surprises:

Deck the halls, but don't overload the sockets

Using extension cords wisely is key. Plugging too many decorations into one socket can cause overheating and potentially start a fire. Spread out your decorations across different outlets or use a power strip with a built-in circuit breaker.

Twinkling lights, but not overnight

Remember to turn off Christmas lights and decorations before going to bed or leaving the house. Lights can overheat and cause a fire if left on for too long. Setting a timer for your lights to automatically turn off at a certain time each night can be a great help.

Keep the tree fresh and hydrated

Did you know a real Christmas tree can be more of a fire hazard than an artificial one? Artificial trees are usually fire retardant. Real trees require watering and can absorb up to a litre of water a day, so it's important you don't let them dry out.

Candles are lovely, but be careful

Place candles in sturdy holders and keep them away from flammable materials. Candles can easily tip over and start a fire. Consider using batteryoperated candles for a safer alternative.

Cooking up a storm? Stay in the kitchen

Never leave cooking unattended, especially when using the stove or oven. Unattended cooking is a leading cause of house fires. Set a timer to remind you to check on your food regularly.

Check your alarms

Test your smoke alarms and replace batteries if needed. Working smoke alarms can give you an early warning in case of a fire.

Got an e-bike for Christmas? Charge it safely!

E-bikes are a fantastic gift, but it's important to charge them safely. Always use the charger that came with the bike and avoid charging it overnight or unattended. Make sure to charge your e-bike in a well-ventilated area and keep it away from flammable materials.

Keep your health in check!


As it's chilly, you're most likely to have your heating on. So, to keep your home warm invest in draft excluders and cover bare, wooden floors with a rug.
